

ABOUT THE PING JUNIOR SOLHEIM CUP

Inaugurated in 2002, the PING Junior Solheim Cup is a version of The Solheim Cup for female amateurs aged 18 and under (born 2005 and later) and follows a similar format to the senior event, featuring the top 12 European junior amateurs versus their American counterparts. To qualify to represent Europe, a selection of European amateur events have be chosen from the 2023 season to count as qualifying events and points will be distributed for a unique PING Junior Solheim Cup ranking. The teams will be selected in August 2023.

The aim of the competition is to give junior golfers from both sides of the Atlantic the opportunity to gain international match play experience as well as the chance to meet, learn from and be inspired by the professional players playing in The Solheim Cup.

In 2021, the European Team put on a stellar performance on the final day of the PING Junior Solheim Cup to triumph for the first time on the US soil. After leading at the end of day one, Team USA could not keep up with what Team Europe had in store for the twelve single matches. Needing at least 8.5 points out of 12 to secure victory, the European team won nine points with eight wins and two matches halved with a final score of 13 - 11.

EUROPEAN QUALIFICATION

- 12 participants
- Participants must be girls and 12-18 years old (born 2005 or later) and must not have reached their 18th birthday prior to Sunday 1 January 2023.
- Participants must be amateurs and must not be members of a competitive collegiate golf program.
- Participants must be a European citizen (as per IGF National Policy).
- The leading six players from the PING Junior Solheim Cup ranking following the R&A Girls' Amateur Championship will be automatically picked. In the event of a tie for the qualification positions, the selection will be decided based on individual standings on the European Women's Amateur Ranking.
- · Six Captain's Picks.
- All amateur events, the European Women's Amateur Ranking and strokeplay average will be taken into
